Formal swim lessons start at 6 months of age. Between 4 & 6 months, children can start being introduced to a pool environment in a less formal session. This is what Baby Swim is all about!

Your child will need a dedicated Adult (Parent or Carer) in the pool with them to hold and support them during the class. All children will need to wearing a Swim Nappy. Sessions go for 30 minutes, however children this age can start to tire after 20 minutes or so. You are welcome to come and go any time during your booked session.

So, what's the catch?

There's no catch or fine print. Whilst we hope that you will continue with classes after your child's 6 month birthday, the choice is yours. The aim of this FREE offer is to introduce families with infants to the pool in a welcoming and friendly environment. Every child needs to learn to swim, so we hope to be a part of your family's ongoing water education.
